
Sadbhavna Diwas Observed at NSIC

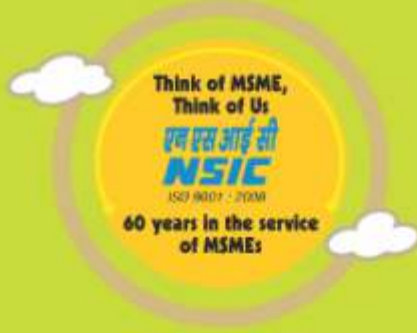

Components of Scheme

- **Livelihood Business Incubation (LBI) Model:** The main objective of this component of the Scheme is to set up business incubators to incubate/impart entrepreneurship, skill development training, mentoring and hand holding, with facilitation for funding with a view to empower youth to set up own business enterprises.

- **Start - Up Promotion :** Small Industries Development Bank Of India (SIDBI) by using innovative means of finance like Equity, Quasi-Equity, Angel fund, Venture capital fund, Impact funds, Challenge funds etc. to enable ideas/innovation with creativity and scalability to come to the fore and convert these into commercial enterprises.

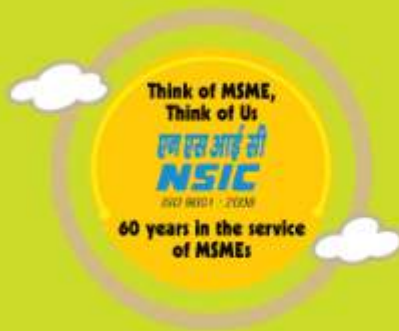
